

POWDER HORN VENTURING ADVISOR OUTDOOR SKILLS TRAINING COURSE

In the Venturing program, the Ranger Award honors those young men and women who hone their outdoor skills to an exceptional degree. To earn this award, a Venturer must demonstrate competence in the areas of First Aid, Communication, Cooking, Emergency Preparedness, Land Navigation, Camping, Conservation, and Wilderness Survival. Additionally, the Venturer must complete ten electives.

The Ranger Award truly demonstrates a young person's skill in the outdoors; every Venturing Leader should have the resources available to guide crew members toward the Ranger Award.

The Powder Horn course is designed to help Venturing and Boy Scout leaders safely conduct outdoor activities of a fun and challenging nature. It provides an introduction to the resources needed to successfully lead Venturers and Boy Scouts through a program of outdoor adventure.

The course is not a total training program which would enable the leader to be an expert or even self-sufficient in aspects of outdoor skills. The Advisor or Boy Scout Leader will still need individuals, known as consultants in the Venturing program, to help provide a safe and correct outdoor / high adventure program.

Participants will get hands on experience in a variety of outdoor program areas. However, Powder Horn is a resource course, not a skill certification course.

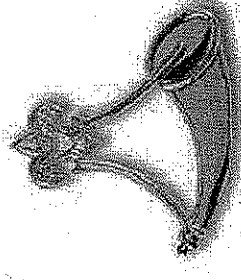
BEAUMONT SCOUT RESERVATION

Beaumont Scout Reservation is one of two facilities operated by the Greater Cleveland Council, Boy Scouts of America (the other is Tinnerman in Canada). It is located just north of Rock Creek, Ohio, on State Route 45. It is 7 miles south of I-90, or 40 miles north of the Ohio Turnpike.

Beaumont offers a variety of programs including Archery, Shotgun, and Rifle Shooting; state-of-the-art COPE Course; climbing/rappelling tower; lakes and pool. The Augustus Training Center, a dozen troop lodges, family cabins, and nineteen campsites provide ample facilities for scouting.

Other topics include working with teenagers, goal setting, expedition planning, and Venturing programs and awards.
