

Hawaii Trip 2009

Rules and Regulations

1. All participants **MUST** be registered Boy Scouts. All adults must be registered. No one under legal boy scout age.
2. ALL participants **MUST** pass the official boy scout swim test.
3. ALL participants must have a class 3 medical form completed within the past year including a copy of your insurance card.
4. All participants must be in good physical condition. Everyone should be able to bike 20 miles up and down hills, swim for long periods of time, hike at least 10 miles with a full pack, and be able to kayak for 4 hours.
5. This **IS** a high adventure trip even though the format is quite different than other high adventure trips. It will be a physically demanding trip.
6. Everyone will participate in every scheduled activity. **NO** Exceptions.
7. No alcohol or fireworks permitted at any time during the trip.
8. Smoking is not prohibited near scouts. Special arrangements will be made.
9. No one is permitted to take any natural objects. This is a place where many people visit, let's leave everything for them to enjoy, too.
10. When snorkeling do not touch any coral. It is very fragile and will die if touched.
11. Any scout or venturer must remain with a buddy at all times. If for some reason we split the large group up, smaller groups must stay together and must contain at least 2 adults.
