We've got the hut for adults who don't want to tent camp. Patrols will tent camp. We can take care of some of the advancement requirements.

Bring your uniform shirt to wear for travel and dinner. Mess kit with cup and utensils, sleeping bag, and a tent for every 2-3 scouts. If you have a knife, bring it. Food and drink will be provided.

We will meet at the St. Basil parking lot on Friday, Oct. 1st at 6:30 pm to load gear into the trailer – we'll leave St. Basils by 6:30. We will return to St. Basils by 9:00 am on Sunday. We will need a few parents to help drive the scouts:

From St. Basil's: Right onto Brecksville Rd (Rt 21), Right on Chippewa Rd (Rt 82) heading West, Left onto Highland, Right on Edgerton Rd., Left on State Rd (South), Right on Center Rd (Rt 94) to dead end at Rt. 303. Right on 303 and quick left onto Rt 606 – Hinckley Hills Rd. Past Bellus Rd about a mile on the right to 1976 Hinckley Hills Rd.
