

Sunday at Camp Manatoc

Now that you're here, what happens next? In order to minimize the time waiting to process in to camp, there are several things that you can do prior to reporting to the camp office to formally check-in to camp.

Arrive directly to your Campsite

Instruct your families to proceed directly to your campsite, and park in the **closest parking lot available**. The [Forms Guidebook](#) has a [map of the camp](#). Please **do not drive vehicles off the roads or parking lots**. **Any vehicles remaining for the week should be relocated to the Administration Building, Dining Hall, or Young Explorers Lodge parking lots before dinner on Sunday.**

The Camp gate will open at 11am. Please do not arrive prior to that time. The check-in will begin at 1pm. Take time to settle your Scouts into their tents, gather the required paperwork (physical forms, releases, rosters (two copies please), tour permits, head counts for additional Wednesday night dinners, medications.) Also have a list of anyone that will be arriving late.

Have your entire unit put on their uniform, gather their swim gear, bring all that paperwork, and come on down to the **Trading Post front porch** (provided it's after 1pm), and check-on-in!

Check-In

During check-in, the unit leader will review your finances, turn in your rosters, get some paperwork for the remainder of your check-in process, and pick up your Staff Guide.

Your Staff Guide will also help make sure that you get to all the stops on the check-in trail. They can answer your questions and help make sure that you get your Troop settled in to camp.



Medical Recheck

Stopping at the Funk Health Lodge, all campers will have their physical forms reviewed. Please insure that all campers have any medications noted on the form available and in **original containers (valid pharmacy sticker on bottle)**. You will be issued a lockable storage container for your campsite storage of non-perishable medications. You will be issued blank buddy tags for your swim checks here.

Dining Hall

Swimming Pool

The Pool offers a brief opportunity to cool off, while you take your annual swim check! All campers planning to use the waterfront (lake) or pool need to complete the check to the best of their ability. A record of all your campers, swim classifications and/or buddy tags will be provided at the end of your week.



Your Campsite

Arriving back at your campsite, you will review the condition of camp issued equipment with your guide. They will complete the final check in form and return it to the office for use during your units check-out.

Sunday following Check-In

O.K., you've completed check-in, now it's time to relax...yea right...the fun is just beginning (literally)...

Waiter Call

OK, it's time to get ready for Dinner. Please send one experienced Scout per assigned table to the Dining Hall to set your unit's places at Dinner. (5:30pm.)

Retreat

Each evening we will have a formal Retreat program. During this program, we may present awards or have another presentation suitable to the occasion. This is also the formal lowering of the Flag and pay respects to H. Karl Butler. Please check the [Program Guide](#) for the specific Retreat procedure.

Dinner

Following the Retreat Ceremony the camp will gather at the newly expanded Dining Hall for the first meal of the week.
