The Troop Philmont Committee will be formed by those attending the meeting, in person or by proxy, who are members of the troop or parents of scouts who are members of the troop.

The committee will be charged with managing all aspects of the Troop 2003 Philmont Trek including:

- whether the troop should participate in the GCC contingent.
- crew membership (who can go)
- fees and funds
- training and equipment sources: troop, personal, combinations
- policies and procedures
- committee membership and positions: who can vote, committee chair, treasurer, secretary, quartermaster, training, etc.

Cliff Bellmore, as the Troop Committee chair, will chair the meeting until the committee elects its own chair. After some introductory remarks, we'll proceed with motions, seconds, discussions, and votes so that we can move quickly.

If you can not attend the meeting but have an interest, please send your comments, questions, etc. to Cliff Bellmore. If you wish to designate someone else to speak for you or to represent your interests, please call Cliff Bellmore at 440-526-4202 and state the "who" and "to what extent" you grant power to others - e.g. can they commit you to spend time or money? If you call, please leave your detailed message instead of "call me's" - I might not be able to return calls before the meeting because of a full schedule.

This will not be a "gripe" session as time is short and we need to move forward quickly. The previous attempt to organize a crew has fallen apart. You can refer to the previous effort but you are not bound by decisions made or positions taken relating to the previous effort. If people want to re-hash old stuff for 20 minutes or so at the start of the meeting, put it to a vote. Otherwise, save it until after the meeting.
