

# Rules and Regulations

- ❑ Half the members of the crew must be youth.
- ❑ Must be a registered Boy Scout.
- ❑ All adults must complete BSA Youth protection training.
- ❑ At least one person must be trained in first aid and CPR and Safety Afloat.
- ❑ All youth must present proper identification with birth date at check in or they will not be allowed to attend Sea Base.
- ❑ Additional people may be added up until final payment.
- ❑ All crews must have at least 2 adult leaders.
- ❑ Sea base has a no-touch/no-take policy with regard to the coral and creatures of the reef.
- ❑ Each participant must provide a front and back copy of his or her insurance cards.
- ❑ DO NOT BRING SUNTAN OIL.
- ❑ NO ONE is allowed to possess or consume any illegal substances or alcohol while at Sea Base. This includes shore leave in Key West.
- ❑ SMOKING IS NOT PERMITTED ON ANY VESSEL OR IN ANY BUILDING.
- ❑ NO portable stereos, Walkman's, MP3's, skateboards, etc.
- ❑ No fireworks are allowed at Sea Base.
- ❑ The menu does not take into account special concerns such as diabetes, vegetarians, allergies, etc. Please bring your own food to accommodate your special needs.
- ❑ Parent's: DO NOT SEND MAIL.
- ❑ No one is allowed to leave the base at any time during your stay.
- ❑ Treat **all** Sea Base equipment with respect and proper care because it is used by the entire scouting community.
- ❑ Sea Base may have to cancel parts of trips or entire trips due to weather conditions. Fees will be refunded as stated in leader's guide.
